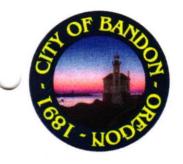

### Bandon Library Board Minutes - 11/21/2024 at 11:30am

Attendance: Sheri Wright, Karen Thomas, Horty Joyce, Michele Schaefer, Christine Kingsbury (Secretary/Library Director), and Cathy Johnston (Coos Library Board member). Absent: James Collins. Meeting called to order at 11:31m by Sheri Wright.

### 3. Reports:

Library Director's Report: (Kingsbury)

- On October 14, 2024 the Coos County Board of Commissioners unanimously approved the new library allocation formula proposed by the Coos Library Board. The plan includes a four-year transition period. The library would like to thank the City of Bandon and members of the community for their ongoing support throughout this process.
- Ongoing programs include Bandon Art Gallery exhibits, Adult Chess Club, Scholastic Chess Club, BLFF Book Club, Preschool Storytime, Music and Movement Storytime, Discovery Storytime, Bilingual Storytime, Washed Ashore Storytime, Friday Freewriting, Apple Lab, Plastic Collection, Seed Library, Storytelling Café, Age Café, High School Hangout, Windows Computer Lab, sports checkout, OSU nutrition presentations, and 0-5 Open Play.
- Upcoming special programs include an ornament making day, "Fuel into Energy" nutrition presentation, and a BLFF celebration honoring the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the current library location.
- The StoryWalk currently displays stories from a local 5<sup>th</sup> grade class.
- Staff are working on creating new programs for homeschool families.
- The library has applied for a grant through Bandon Dunes for new books for the main collection. We are looking at applying for a grant through the ALA to upgrade lighting in the stacks to LED as the area is very dark making it difficult to see book spines. The BLFF Lifetime Members Club has graciously donated funding toward

- new windows in the children's room that will open. This room gets very warm and stuffy during summer youth programs with no ventilation. Any extra funding will be put toward new books for our collection.
- The early literacy programs, made possible by the South Coast Early Learning Hub, are growing in attendance. Our new facilitator is doing an amazing job building a quality, engaging program.

Bandon Library Friends and Foundation Report: (Thomas/Johnston/Joyce)

- · Thomas and Johnston provided an update from the recent BLFF meeting.
- A 20-year anniversary celebration for the library's current location is being hosted by the BLFF on December 7<sup>th</sup> at 1pm. A slideshow, refreshments, and speakers are planned.
- The BLFF Silent Auction was a big success.
- A fundraiser is currently in the works featuring an author talk with Barbara O'Neal on February 8<sup>th</sup> at 1pm in the Sprague Room (Suggested donation of \$20 per person).
- Upcoming book sales and never-ending book sales were discussed. Upcoming sales
  are scheduled for April and July, with the silent auction returning in October.
- A new promotional committee has created a new logo for the BLFF. A new brochure and banner are in the works.
- The gallery will soon be showing the works of Judith Ginsburg.
- The next meeting for the BLFF will be February 27 at 1:30pm.

### **Bandon Library Director's Report February 2025:**

Last November, the library celebrated 20 years of being housed in the current building, thanks to the city and community coming together to make its creation a reality. The Bandon Library Friends and Foundation hosted the anniversary celebration to include a historical presentation by Mayor Schamehorn and Peter Braun. I feel fortunate to be able to serve our amazing community in such a beautiful facility!

The library was recently awarded a grant for \$13,000 from the Bandon Dunes Charitable Foundation to purchase new books for our collection! Funds to purchase all new books come from grants and donations. We are extremely grateful for the Bandon Dunes Charitable Foundation's support in helping the library provide a relevant and quality collection for our community all year long. The library was also the recipient of a \$2000 grant from the South Coast Early Learning Hub for materials to support our growing early literacy program. Funds will be used to purchase materials to support storytime, Open Play, and STEM programming for ages 0-6.

We are excited to announce new programs now being offered at the library. Through direct input from our community, we are now offering a Spanish conversational group, an "All Things Internet" computer lab, and a Homeschool Connect program serving homeschool families in our area.

Our ongoing programs include Bandon Art Gallery exhibits, Adult Chess Club, Scholastic Chess Club, BLFF Book Club, Preschool Storytime, Music and Movement Storytime, Bilingual Storytime, Washed Ashore Storytime, Friday Freewriting, Apple Lab, Plastic Collection, Seed Library, Storytelling Café, Age Café, High School Hangout, Windows Computer Lab, sports checkout, OSU nutrition presentations, Homeschool Connect, All Things Internet Lab, Spanish conversation group, and 0-5 Open Play. Upcoming special programs include a

heart health nutrition series by OSU Extension, "Aging Well at Home" presentation, Shoreline Education Awareness presentations, a Celtic Harp concert featuring Aryeh Frankfurter and Lisa Lynne and an astronomy presentation by Dr Coyner of SWOCC.

The new windows for the children's room were installed last month! The Bandon Library Friends and Foundation Lifetime Members Club graciously donated funding to purchase the windows which can now be opened for much needed air flow. Extra funds left over after the purchase of the windows will be used to provide new large print books for our collection.

It is hard to believe that it is already 2025 and I am excited to see what the new year holds for our library. Thank you for your dedication and support as we move into 2025!
